Eligibility

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

Only complete applications will be considered. All applications must be submitted electronically via email to GradInfo@asu.edu

Each application should include the following items:

1. **Completed PFX Application Form (see next page)**
2. **Statement of Purpose**
The statement of purpose should describe the student's goals as a potential faculty member in higher education and how participation in PFX would help the student achieve these goals. (1-2 double spaced pages, 12-point font, one-inch margins required, and name at top of each page)
3. **Faculty Advisor Recommendation** (*In the space provided, indicate why the applicant would benefit from PFX, and what you see as their potential for a faculty career.*)
