1	Maintain Continuous Enrollment	Students must be enrolled for a minimum of one credit hour in a graduate-level course every term or a designated UG deficiency course or 400-level course approved on their iPOS	Click Here
2	Degree Time Limits	Students in master's programs have 6 years to complete the degree. Students in doctoral programs have 10 years.	Click Here
3	Degree Requirements	Graduate students are required to fulfill the degrees requirements approved for their catalog year. All degrees require successful completion of at least one culminating experience as a graduation requirement.	Click Here
4	Defenses	Graduate programs that require a defense must follow guidelines for the defense and formatting per policy. The stated deadlines must be met for degree conferral for that term. Students have up to one year to complete revisions and must maintain continuous enrollment during that time.	Click Here
5	Incomplete Grades	A student receiving an Incomplete grade has one calendar year to complete the course and have a regular grade assigned. After one year, the I grade becomes permanent on the record.	Click Here
6	Graduation	All students must apply for graduation, including students completing certificates, in order to officially complete the degree/certificate.	Click Here
7	Interactive Plan of Study (iPOS)	All graduate students are required to submit an iPOS. Approval is required in the first term of a student's program beginning Fall 2022.	Click Here
8	Satisfactory Academic Progress	Graduate students must maintain at least a 3.0 GPA in each of the three GPAs during their graduate studies and make systematic progress towards the completion of their degree.	Click Here
9	Academic Integrity	Graduate College expects all students to act with the highest standards of academic integrity and comply with the university's Student Code of Conduct. Failure to uphold these standards may result in serious consequences.	Click Here
